





Change in Population by Source, 2010-2017 (millions)













Projected U.S. Population by Generation












Nature of Work




U.S. Employment by Job Type




Percent of Selected Jobs that Could be Automated Using Existing Technology


Florida's \$1 Trillion GDP by Industry – Q1 2018 (\$Billion)



Projected Gross Domestic Product Growth by Region, 2016-2030








Global Growth in Cross-Border Flows, 2002-2014






Getting Worse *Findings as of 11/2017

How Central FL Region Differed – BETTER than State Composite






