
















Did We Accomplish Our Goals?

Grow Florida jobs in trade, transportation, logistics, export-oriented manufacturing & related value-added services


Expand Florida's market share on critical global trade lanes

World's most capable spaceport; toptier airports, seaports, and surface transportation hubs in U.S.


