The Florida Chamber of Commerce urges you to **support HB 671**, related to unemployment compensation fraud. This bill, sponsored by Representative La Rosa, will be heard Tuesday, March 21, 2017, in the House Transportation & Infrastructure Subcommittee.

The Florida Chamber supports efforts to lower the burden of unemployment compensation taxes for Florida's job creators. HB 671 creates a mechanism for the Department of Economic Opportunity to identify and prosecute fraudulent unemployment compensation claims by allowing them access to certain files of the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles. The Florida Chamber considers this legislation one of its top priorities and the issue has been included in the 2017 Florida Business Agenda.

This legislation is important to Florida's business community because this bill:

- Makes it easier for the Department of Economic Opportunity to pinpoint fraudulent unemployment compensation applications;
- Protects the unemployment compensation system by reducing fraud; and
- Protects the taxpayers that pay into the unemployment compensation system- the job creators.

The Florida Chamber urges you to **support HB 671**, and will consider votes on this legislation, and any substantive amendments to it in committee or on the floor, in our annual *How They Voted* report card. The grade that you earn will be based on your voting record on the issues, such as this one, that are outlined in *Where We Stand*, a guide to Florida's 2017 Business Agenda. We will make every effort to notify you prior to a vote that may be included in our annual legislative report card.
