Side-by-Side Comparison

Governor AND Legislature

- Increase minimum age for firearms purchase from 18 to 21 (ALL guns)
 - Exceptions: Active-duty military, national guard, law enforcement (and their spouses)
- Ban bump stocks
- Various levels of funding for school safety measures and mental health services
- Additional resource officers
- Additional restrictions for gun ownership/purchase (Baker Act)

Side-by-Side Comparison

<u>Legislature</u>

- 3 day wait period for ALL gun purchases
- "Marshal Program"
- Enhanced safety measures with Baker Act
- Establish statewide commission to investigate system failures with Parkland and other mass shootings
- Prevent disclosure of certain personal information of victims/families
- Funding: \$400 million

Side-by-Side Comparison

Governor

- "Violent Threat Restraining Orders"
- Enhanced safety measures with Baker Act
- New "see something, say something" hotline, website and mobile app
- Enhanced criminal penalties for threats to schools, including social media posts
- Funding: \$500 million
