SAFETY REFORMS

In the wake of the Parkland tragedy, Governor Scott and the Florida Legislature are considering bipartisan solutions to help strengthen the safety and security of our children, our schools and Florida's quality of life.

POLICY REFORM	FINAL LAW (SB 7026)
Gun Laws and Access	Increase minimum age for firearms purchase from 18 to 21 (ALL guns). Exceptions: Active-duty military, national guard, law enforcement (and their spouses) Ban bump stocks 3 day wait period for ALL gun purchases
School Hardening	Additional school resource officers Mandatory active shooter training
Mental Health	Enhanced safety measures with Baker Act Increased funding for mental health services for students
Guardian Program	Creates the Coach Aaron Feis Guardian Program (formerly Marshal Program), which would allow school staff to carry firearms after 132 hours of training Exempts those who "exclusively perform classroom duties as classroom teachers" Requires Guardians to undergo at least 12 hours of diversity training
Funding	\$400 Million
