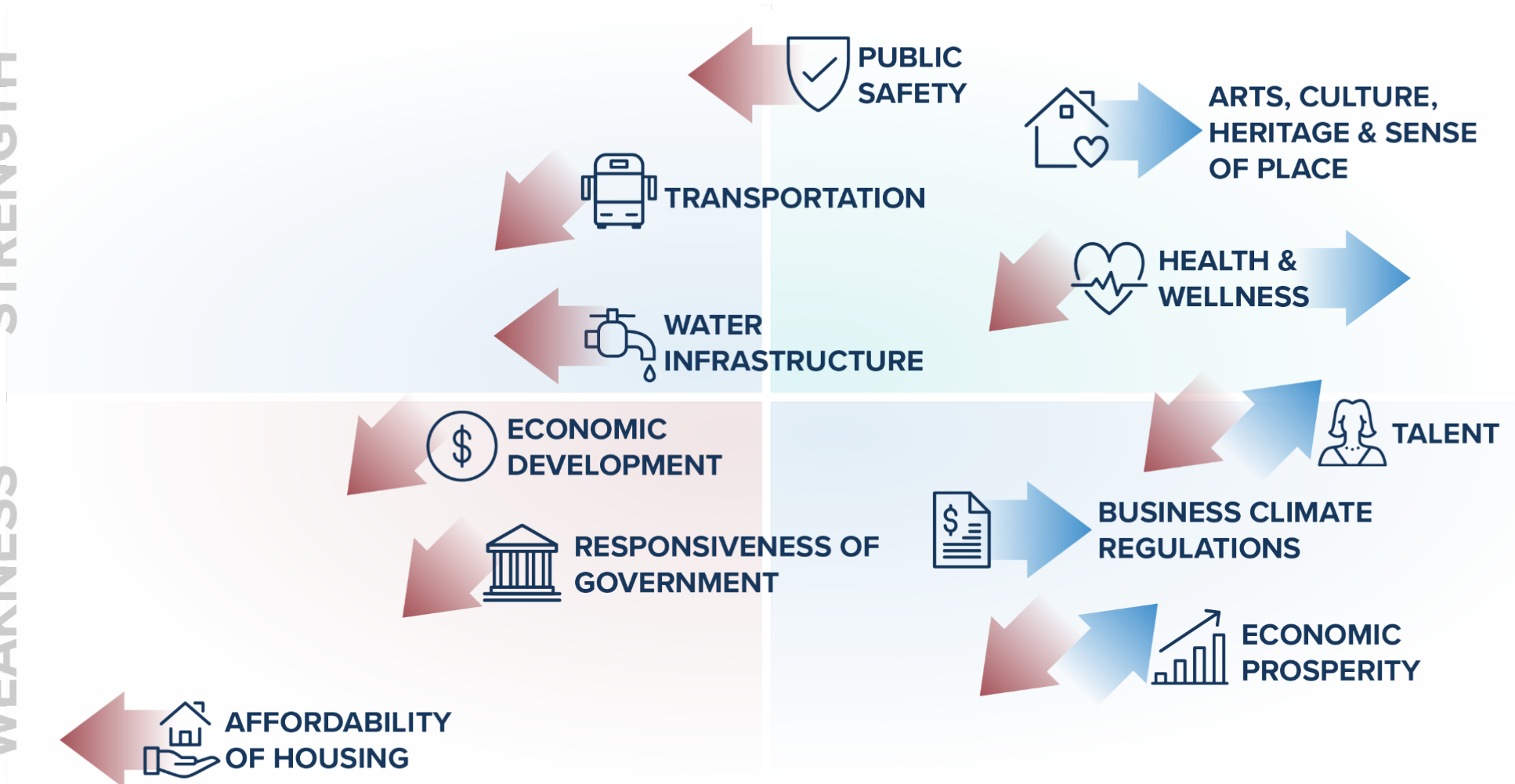

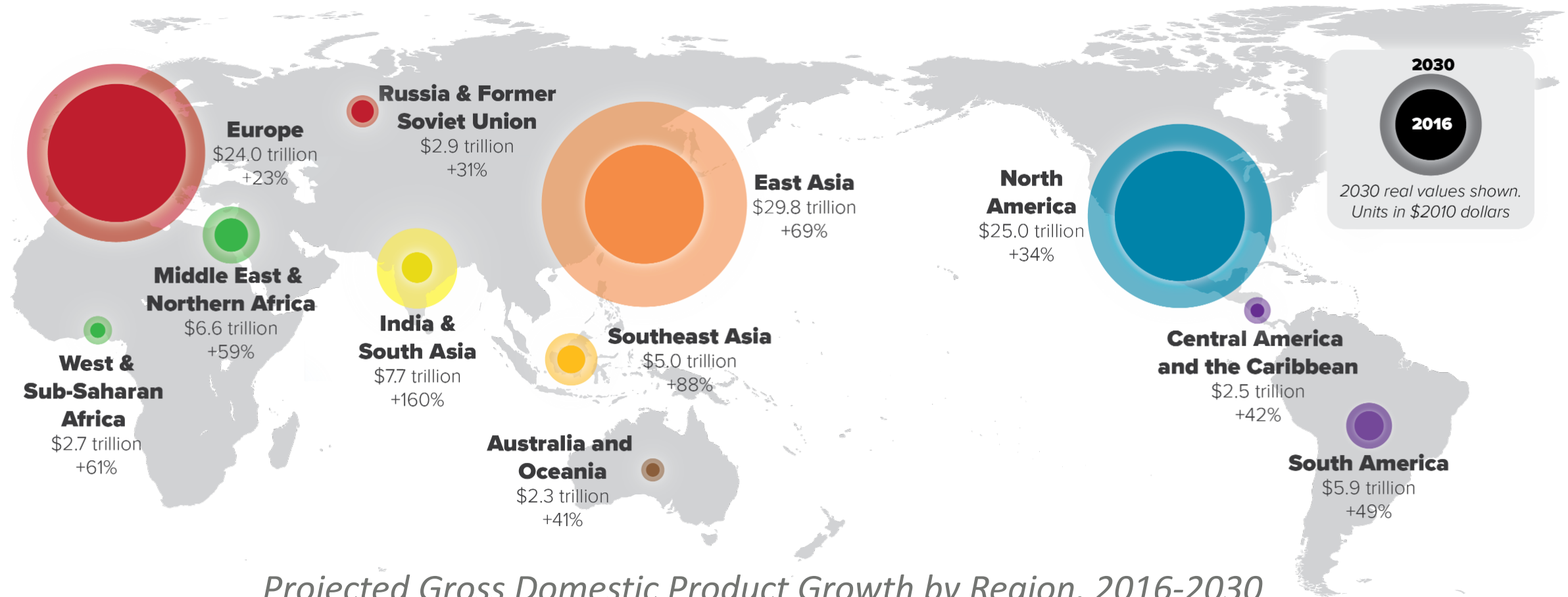

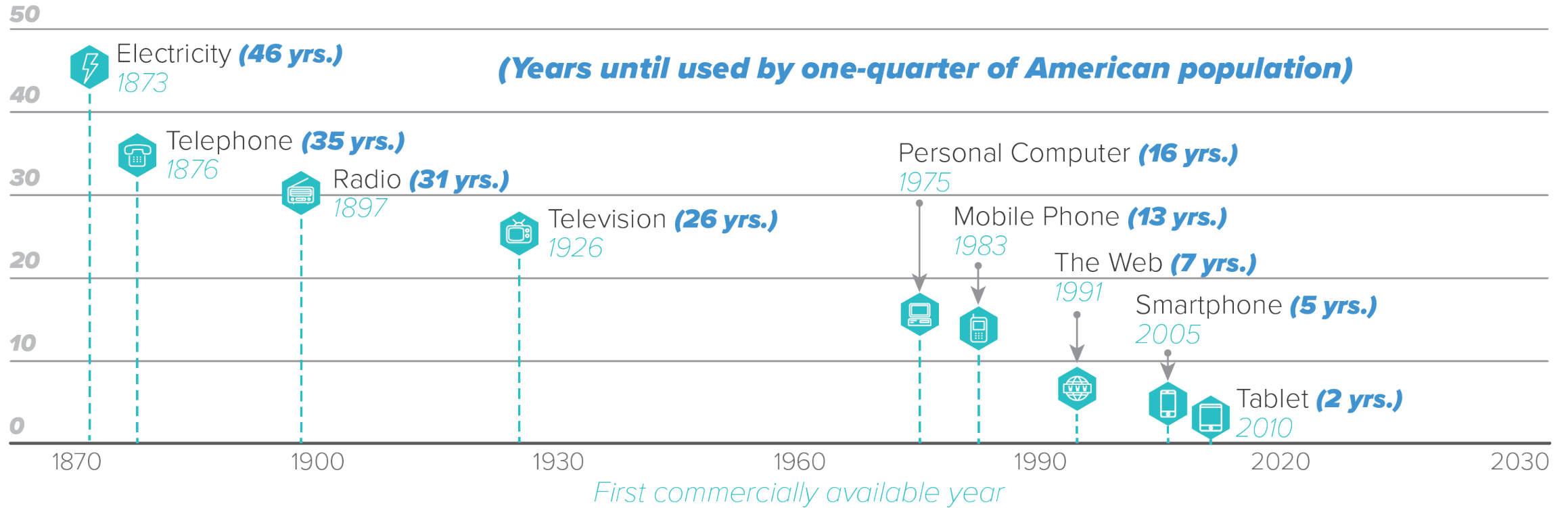

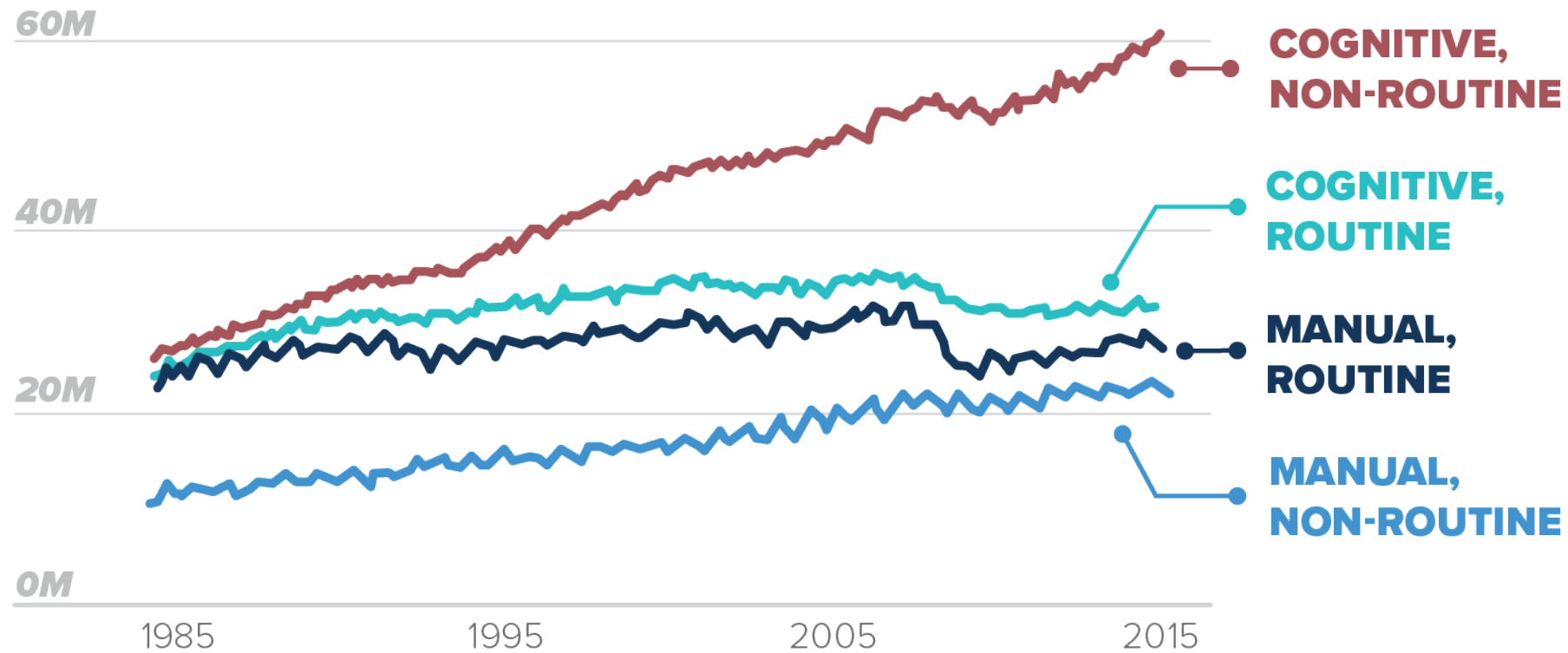

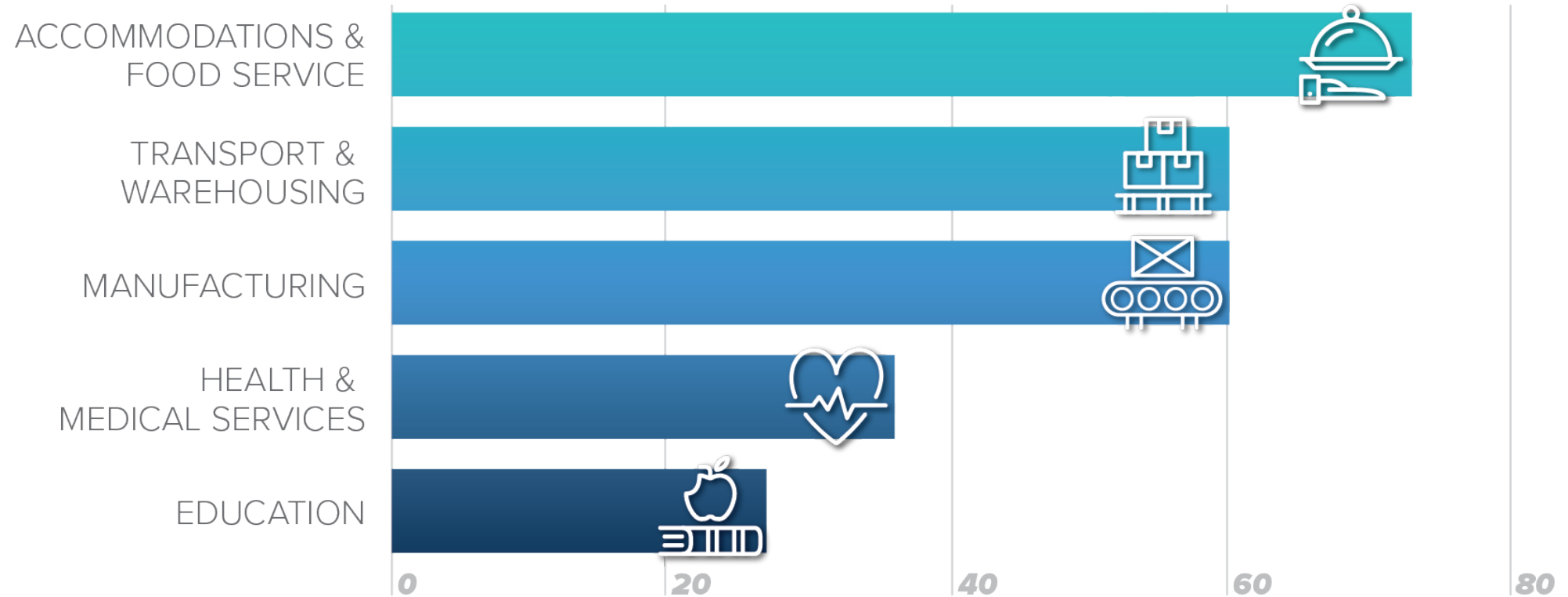


Nature of Work



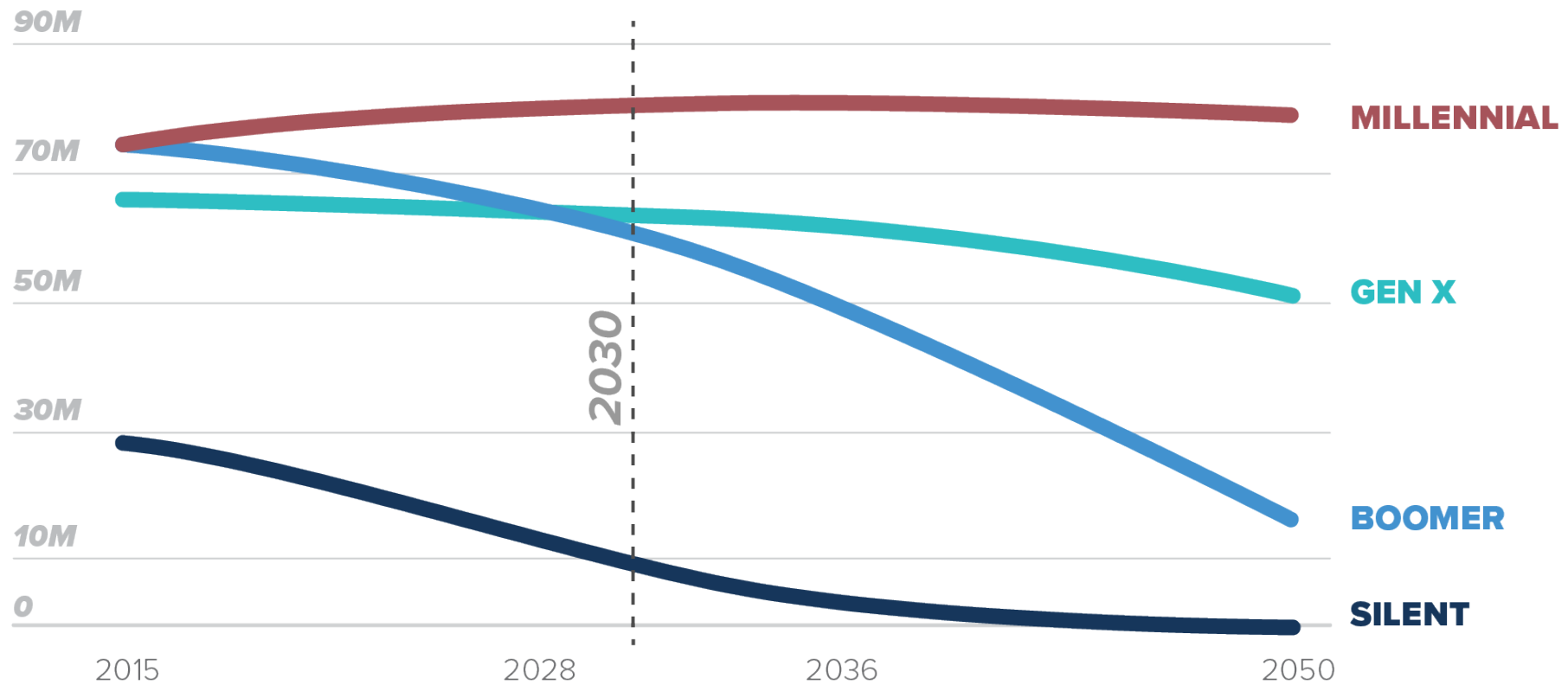
U.S. Employment by Job Type
