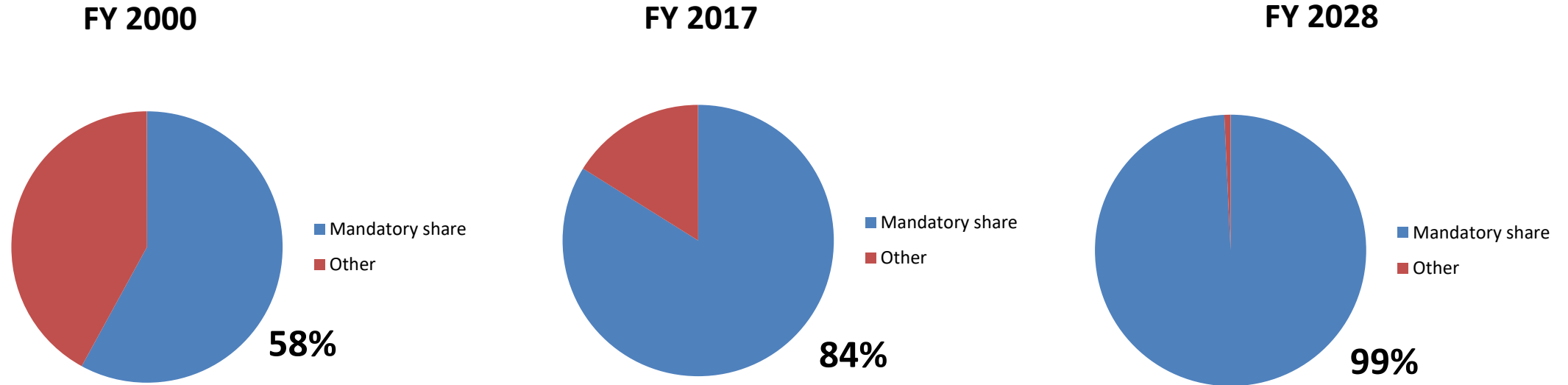

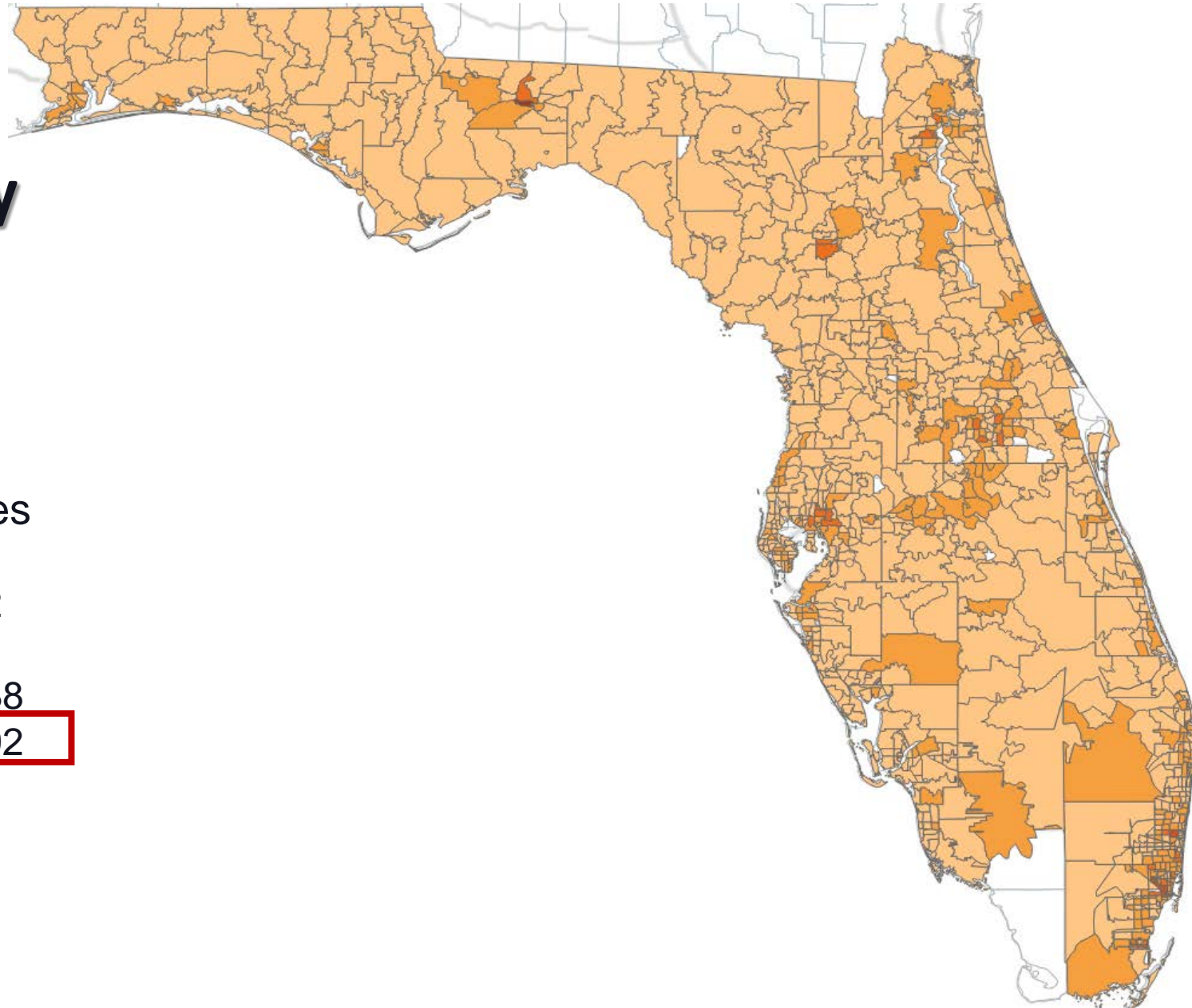

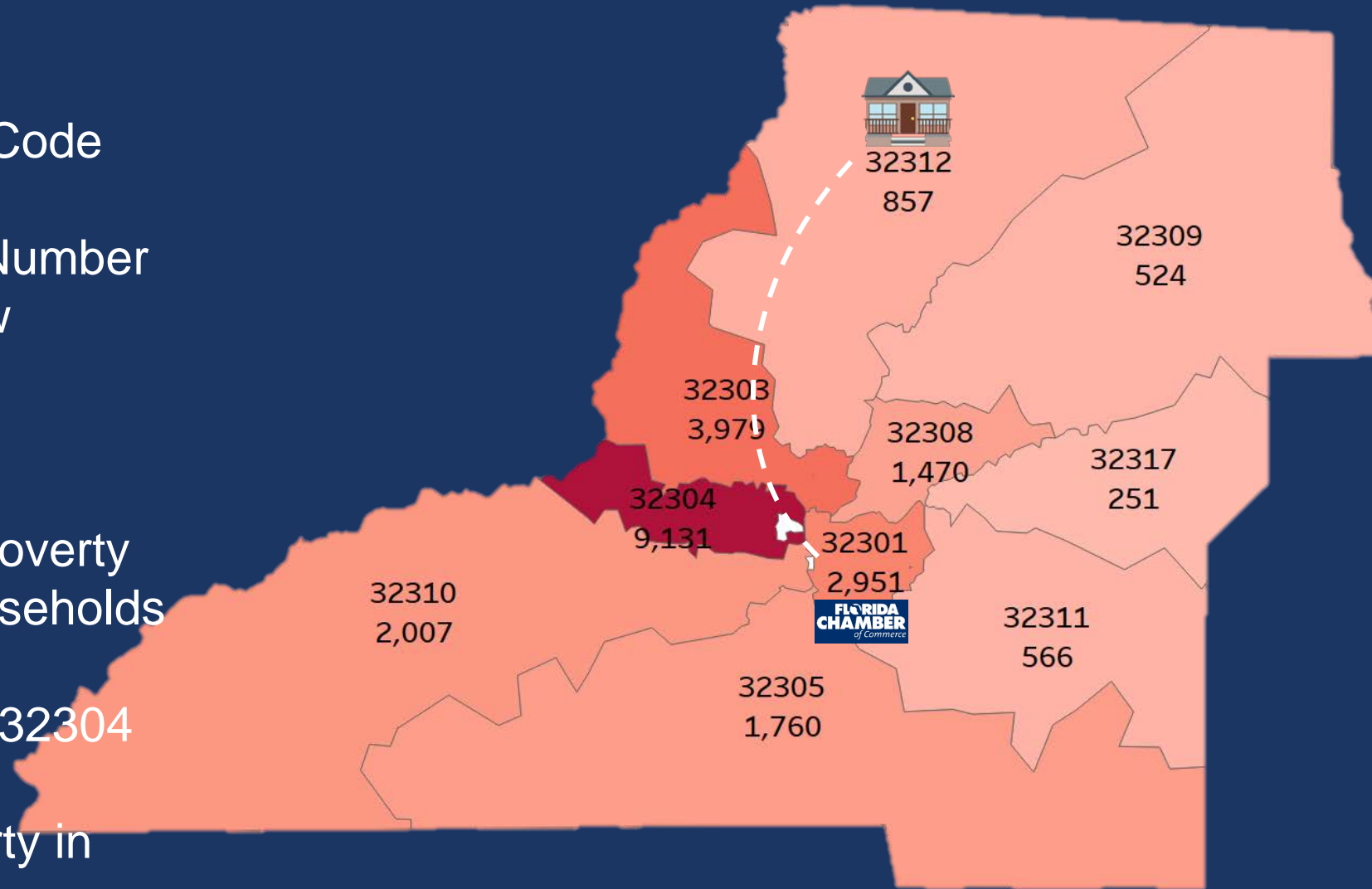

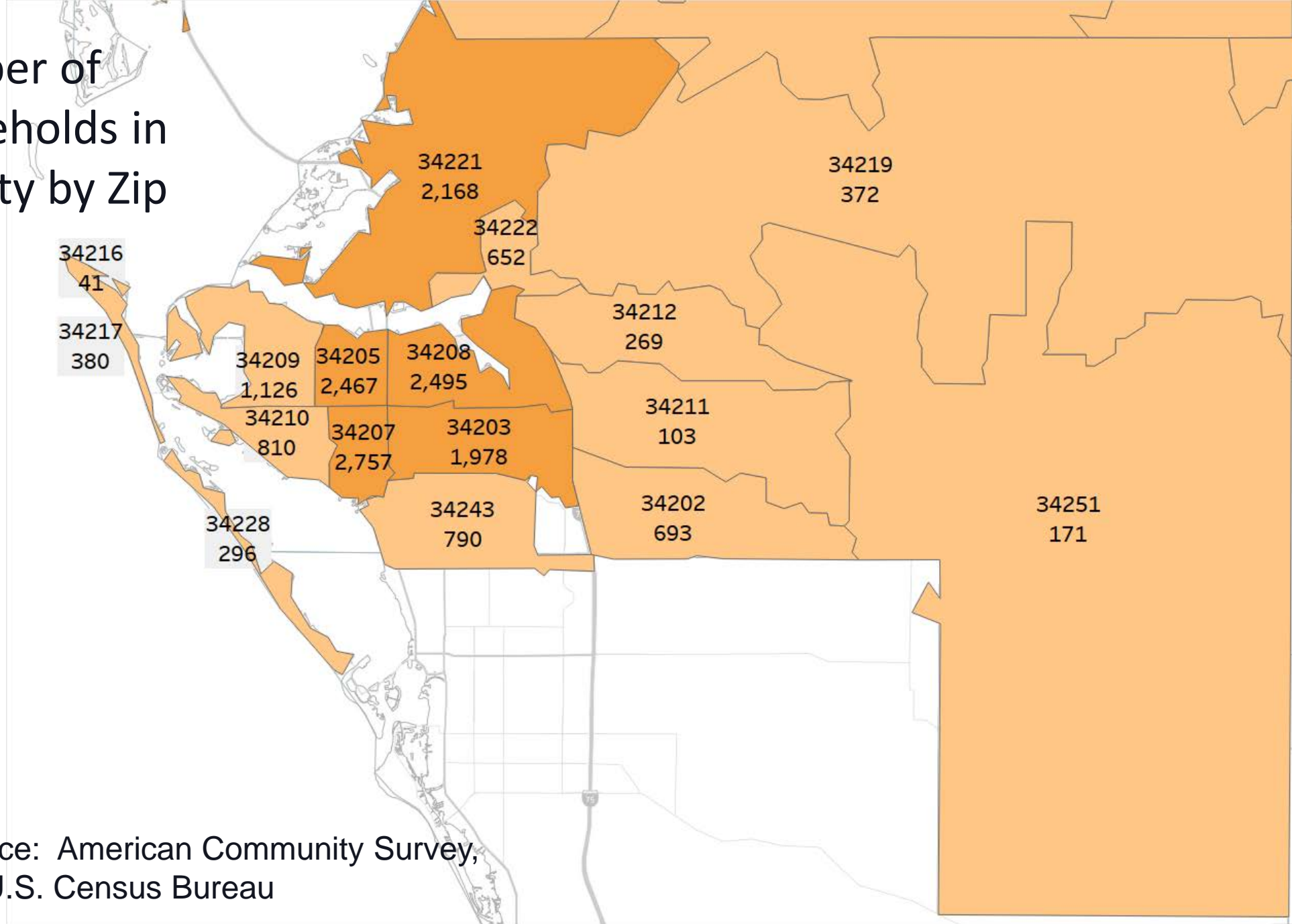

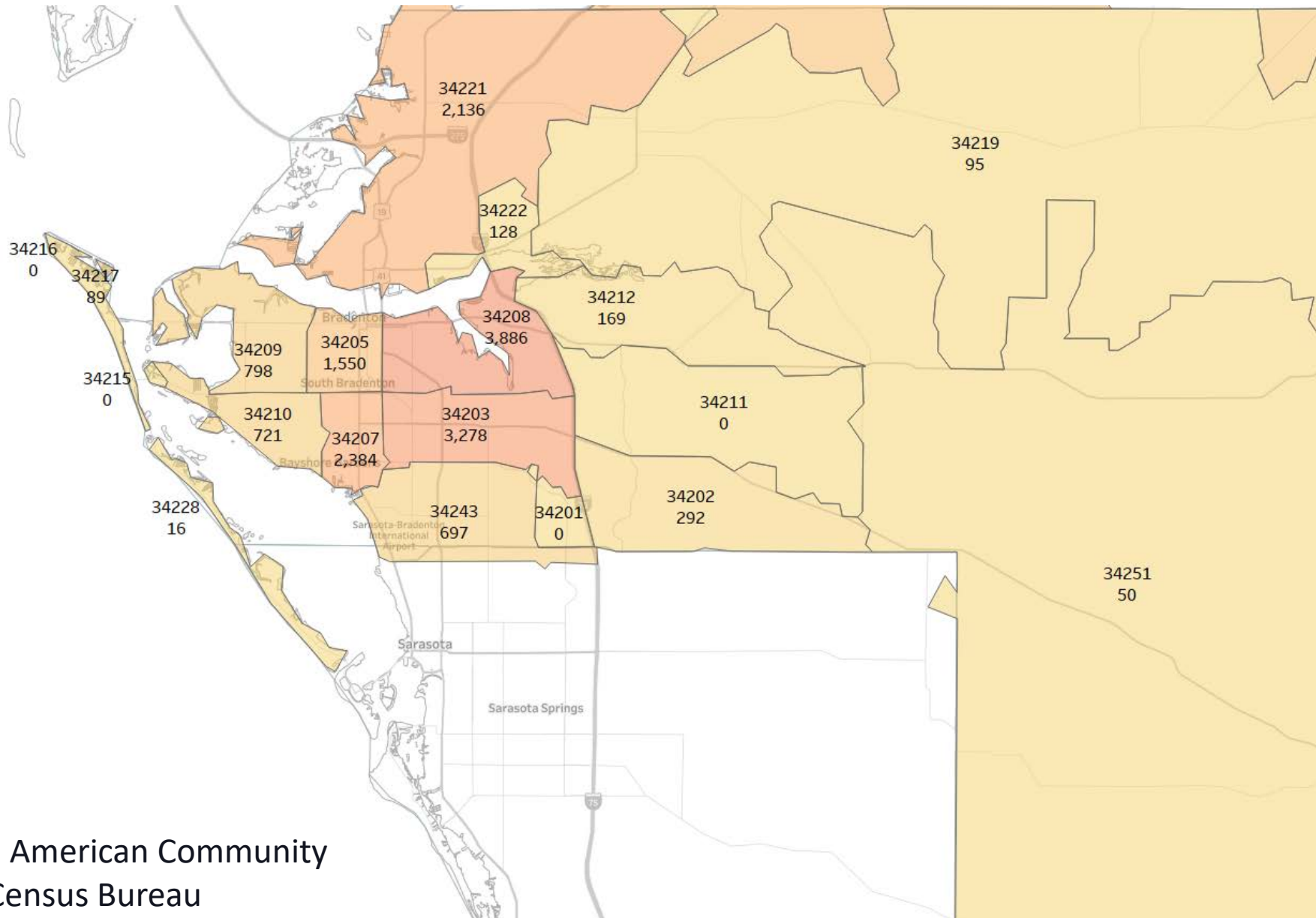
Number of Households in Poverty by Zip Code

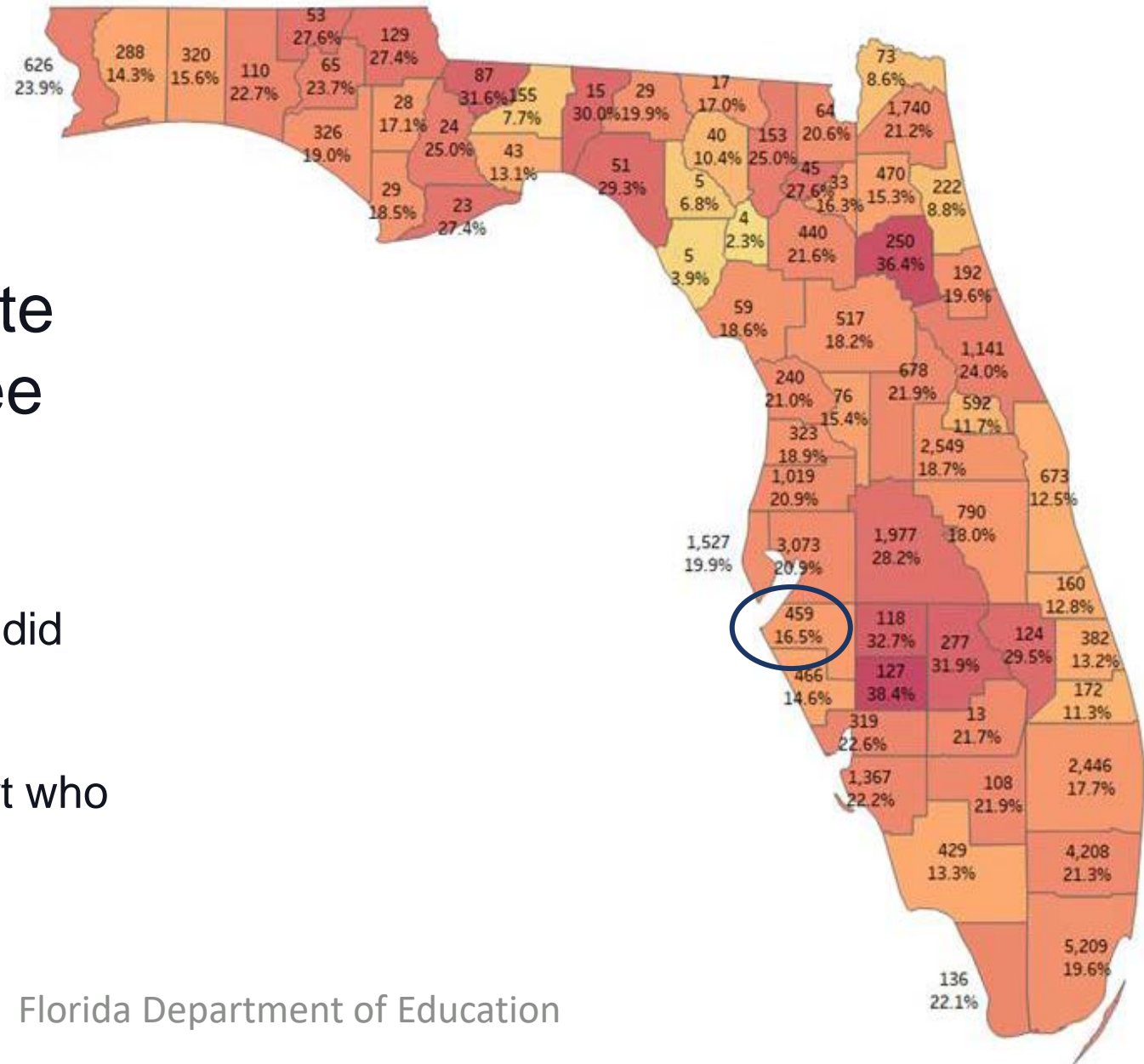

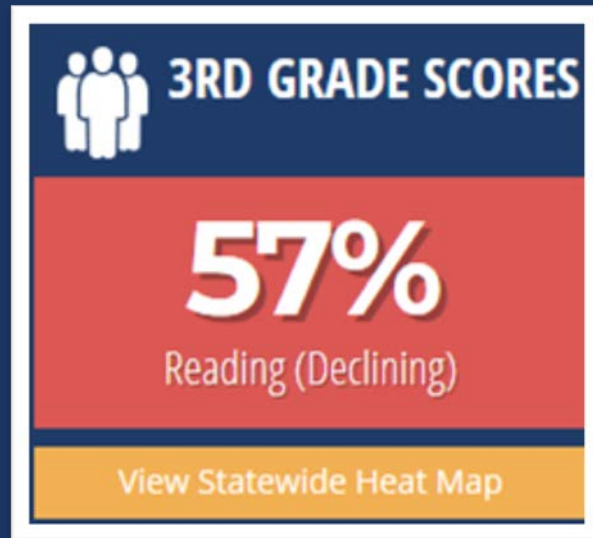
Bottom number: Percent of cohort who did not graduate



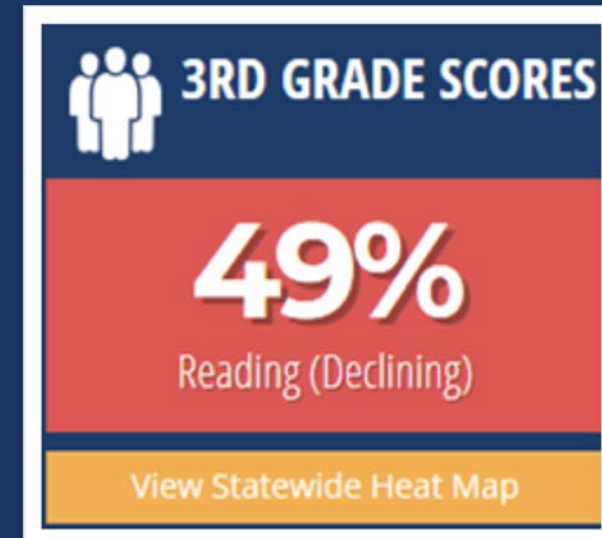

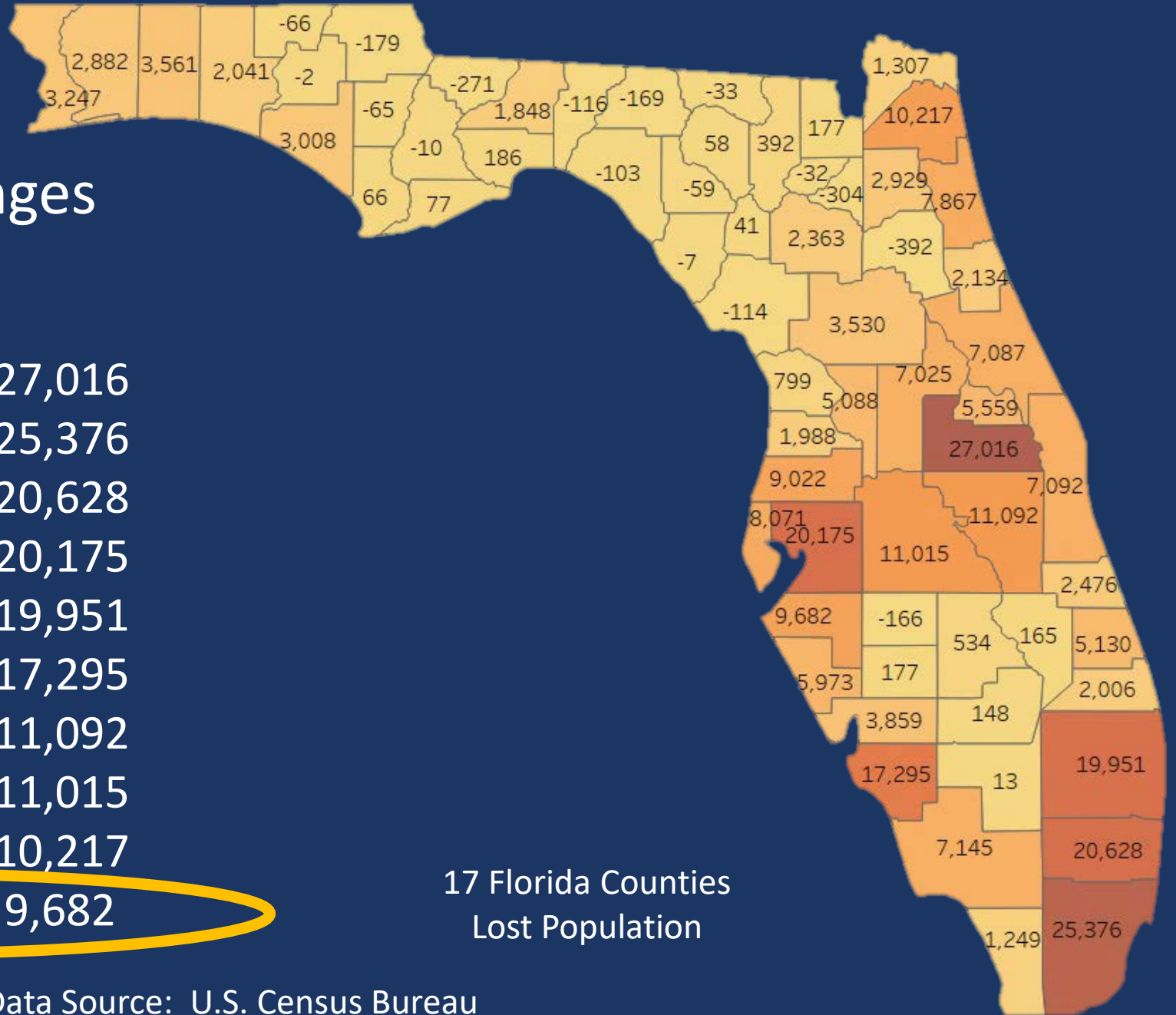

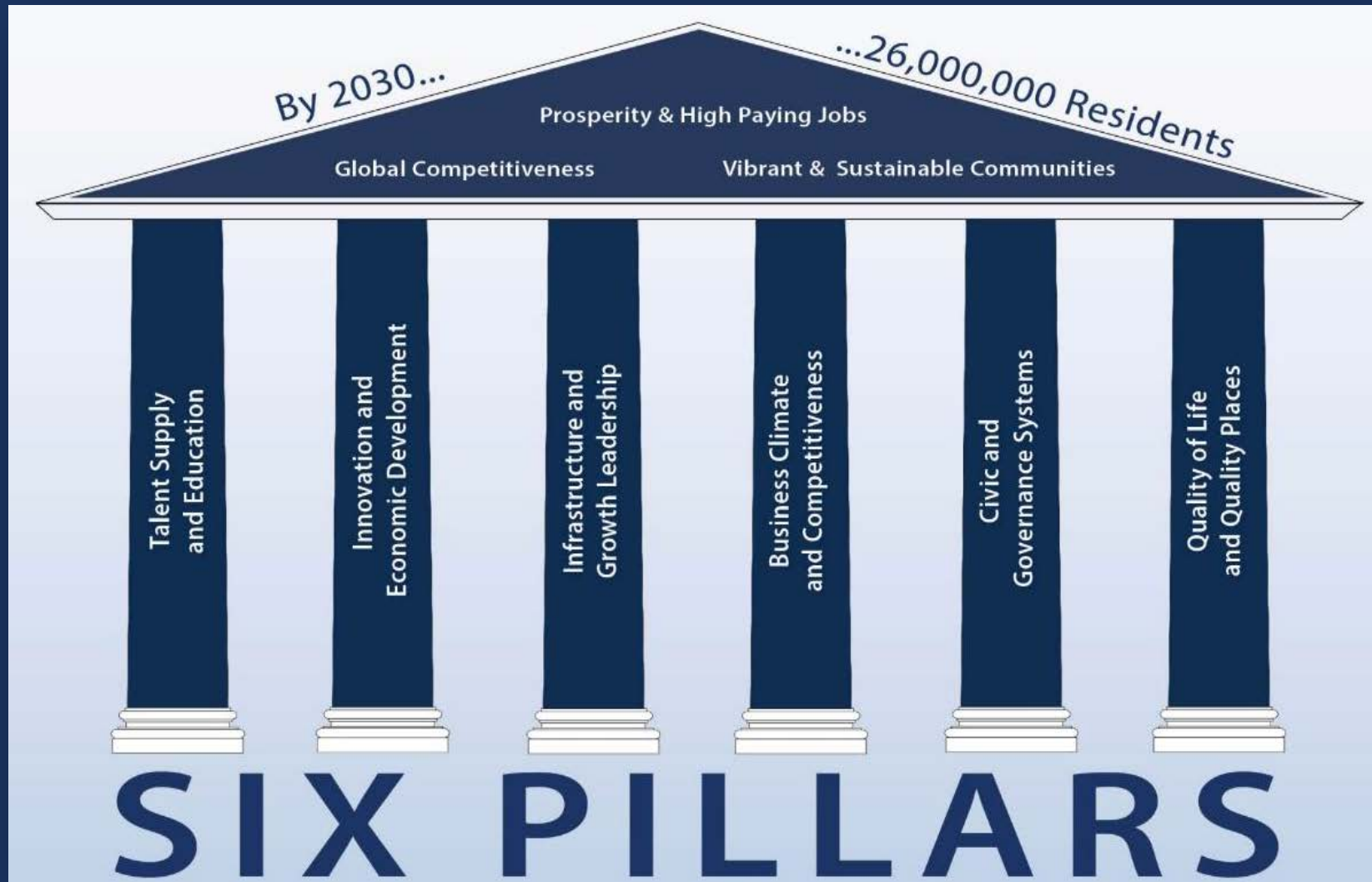

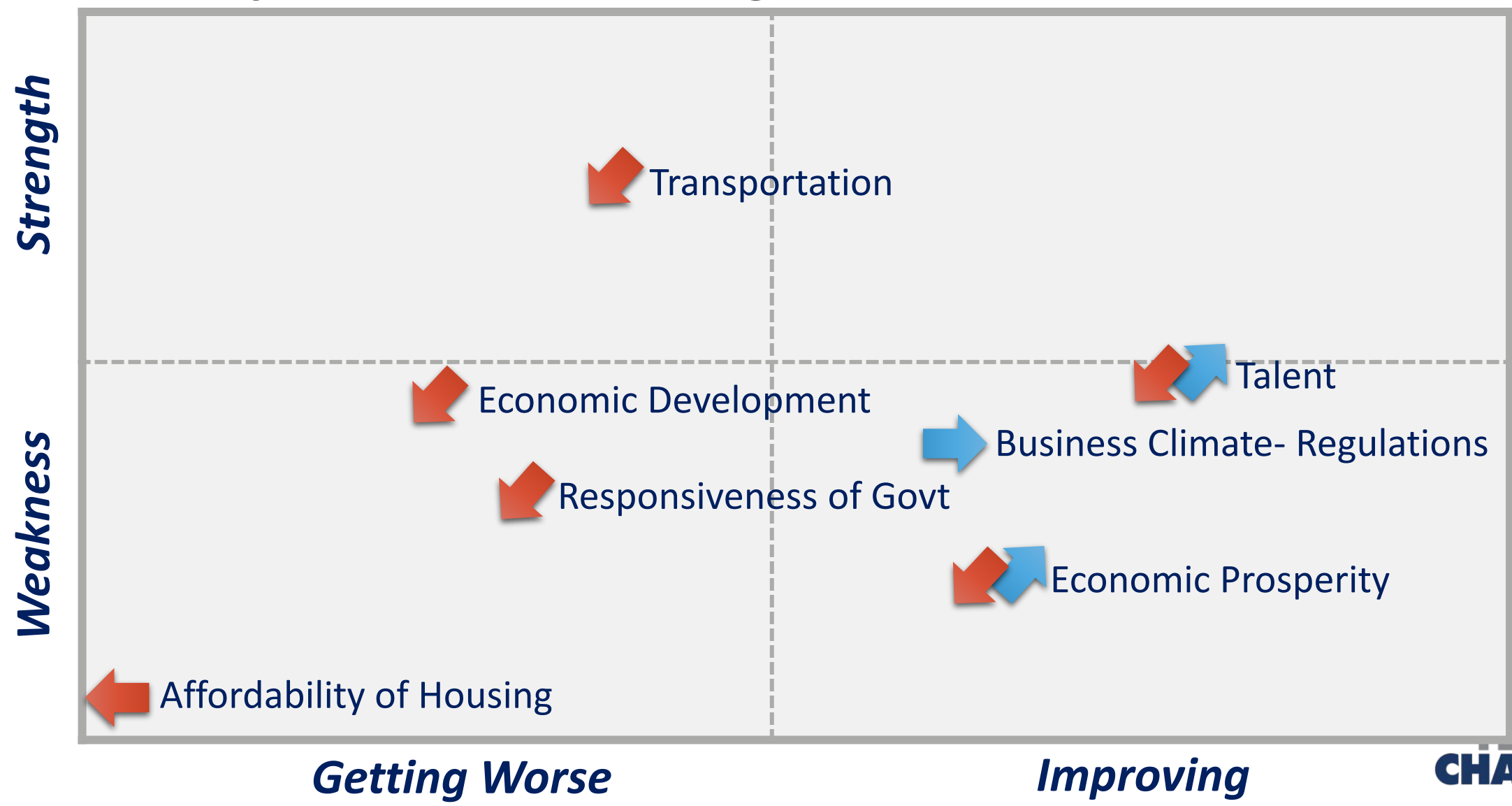


Summary of Town Hall Findings, Statewide Analysis, 2016-17



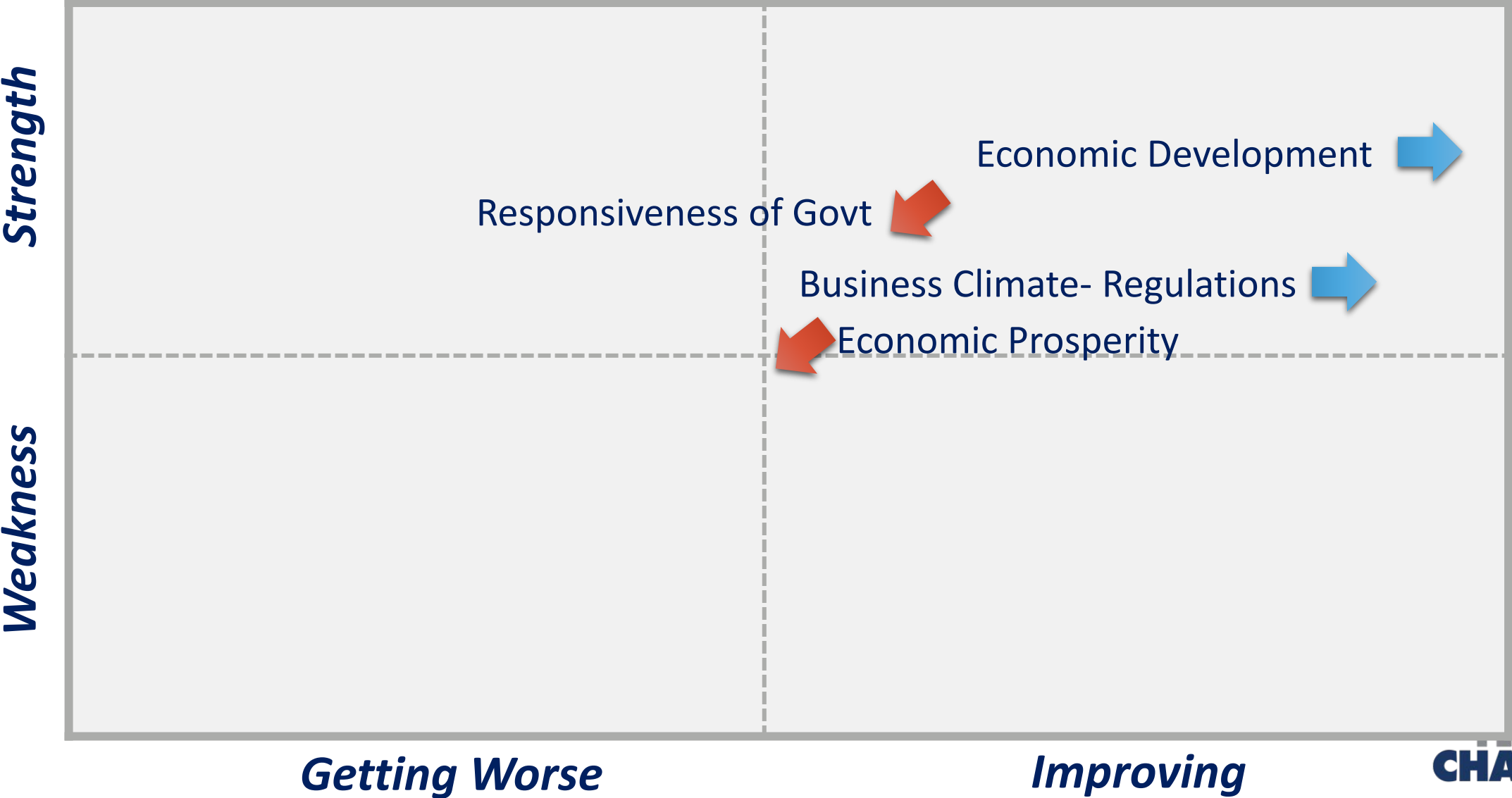

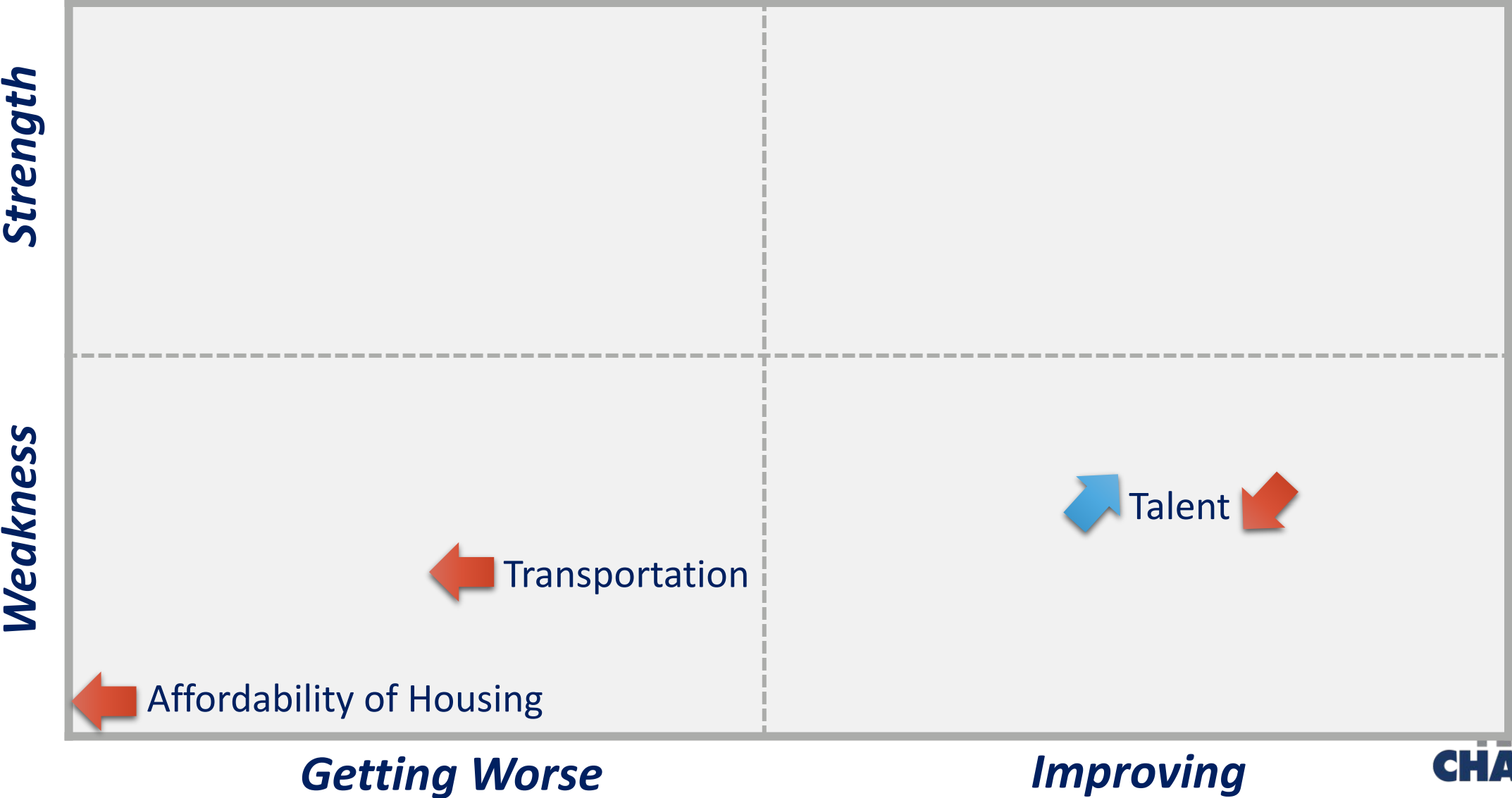
