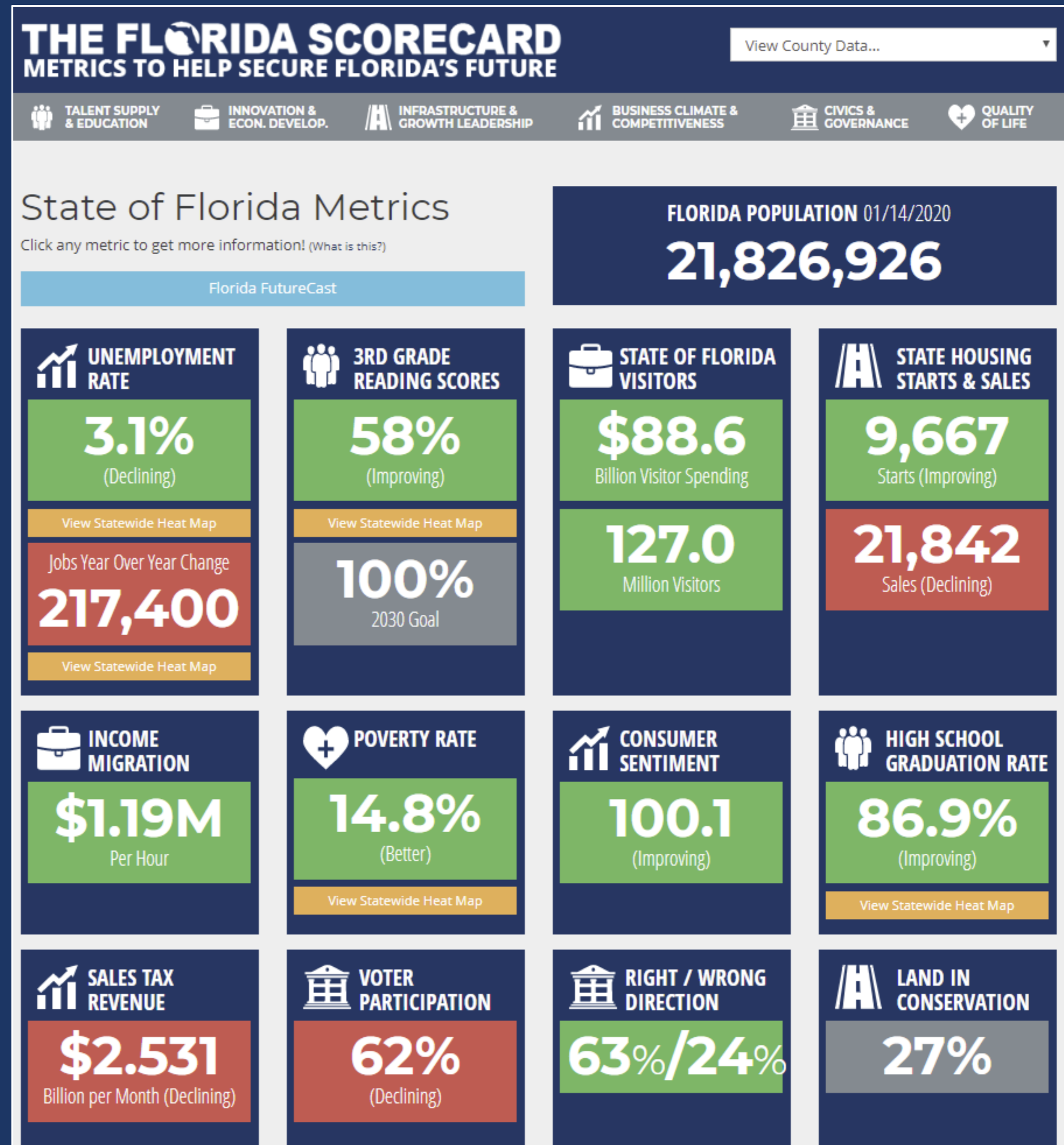
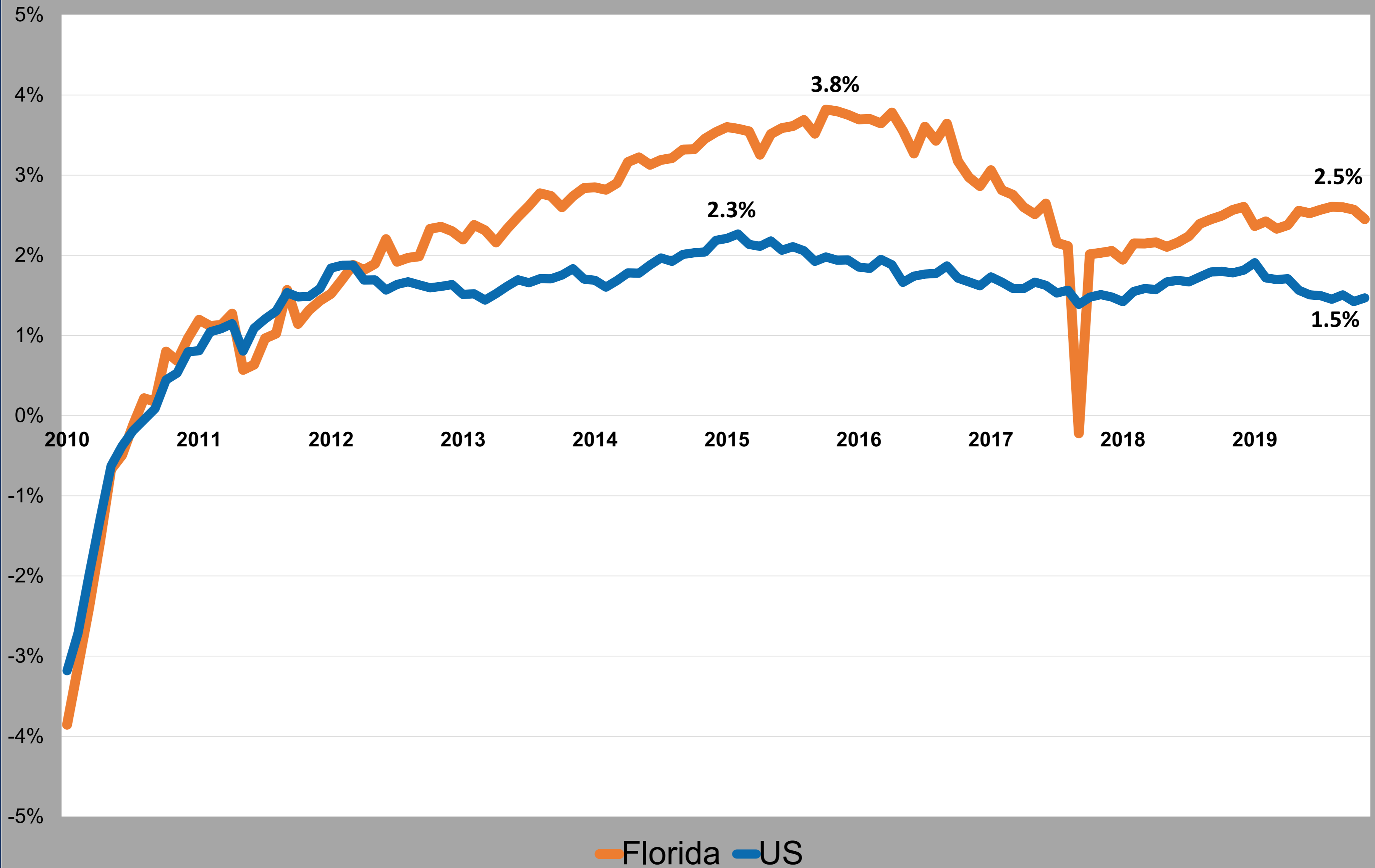

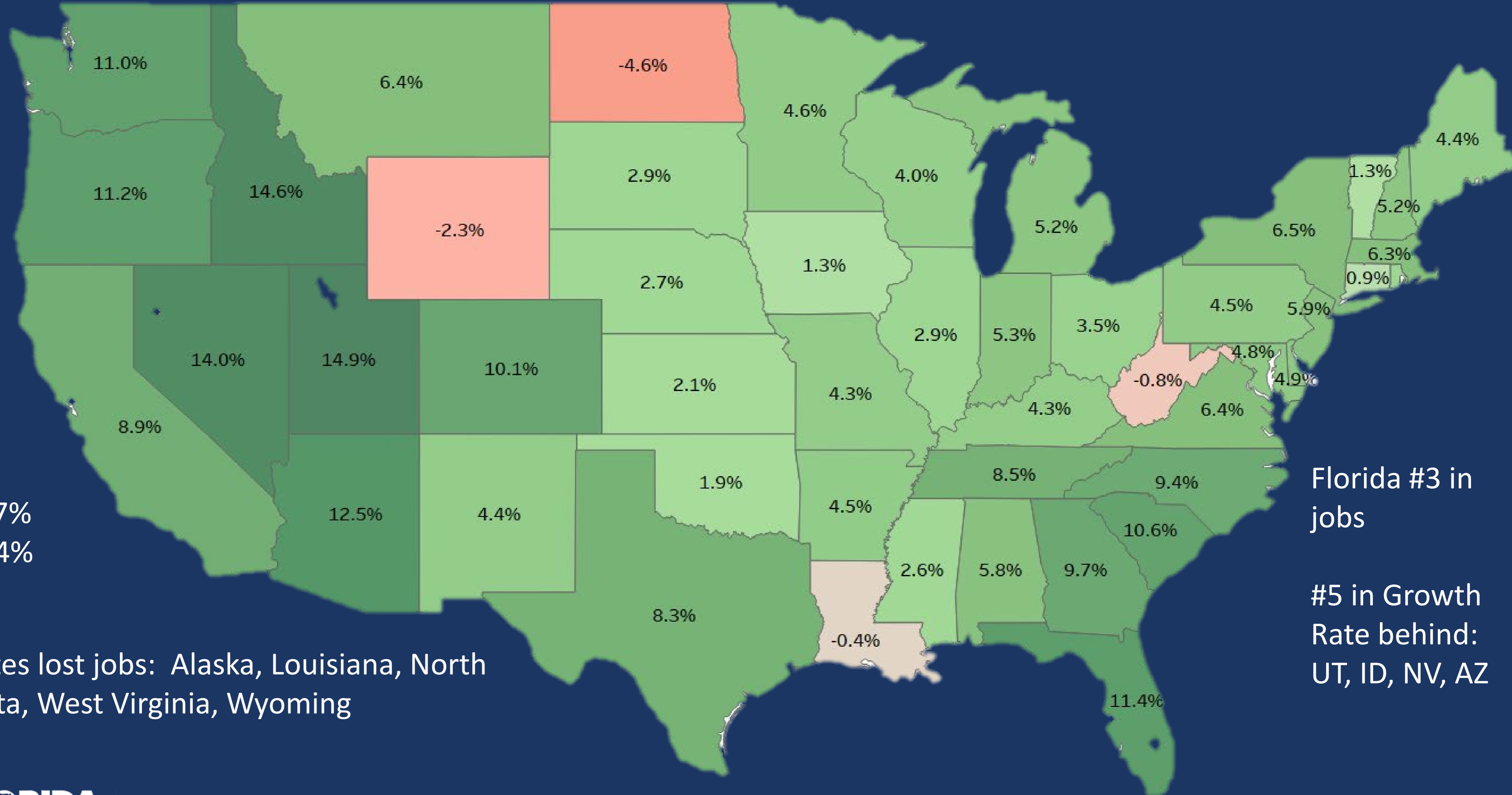
- Florida's Economy \$1.1 Trillion GDP (17th)

Florida Growth Rate: 11.4%

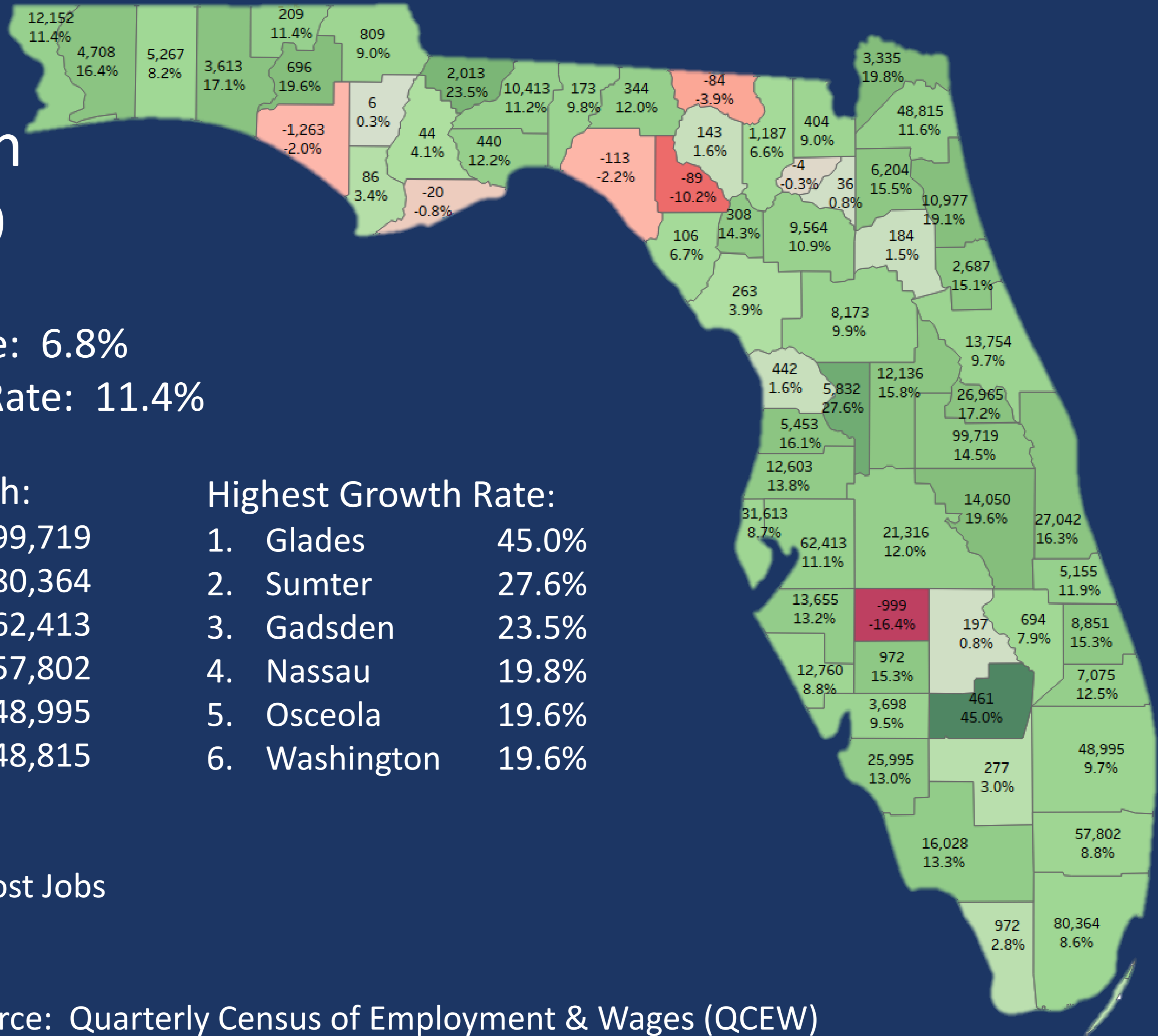

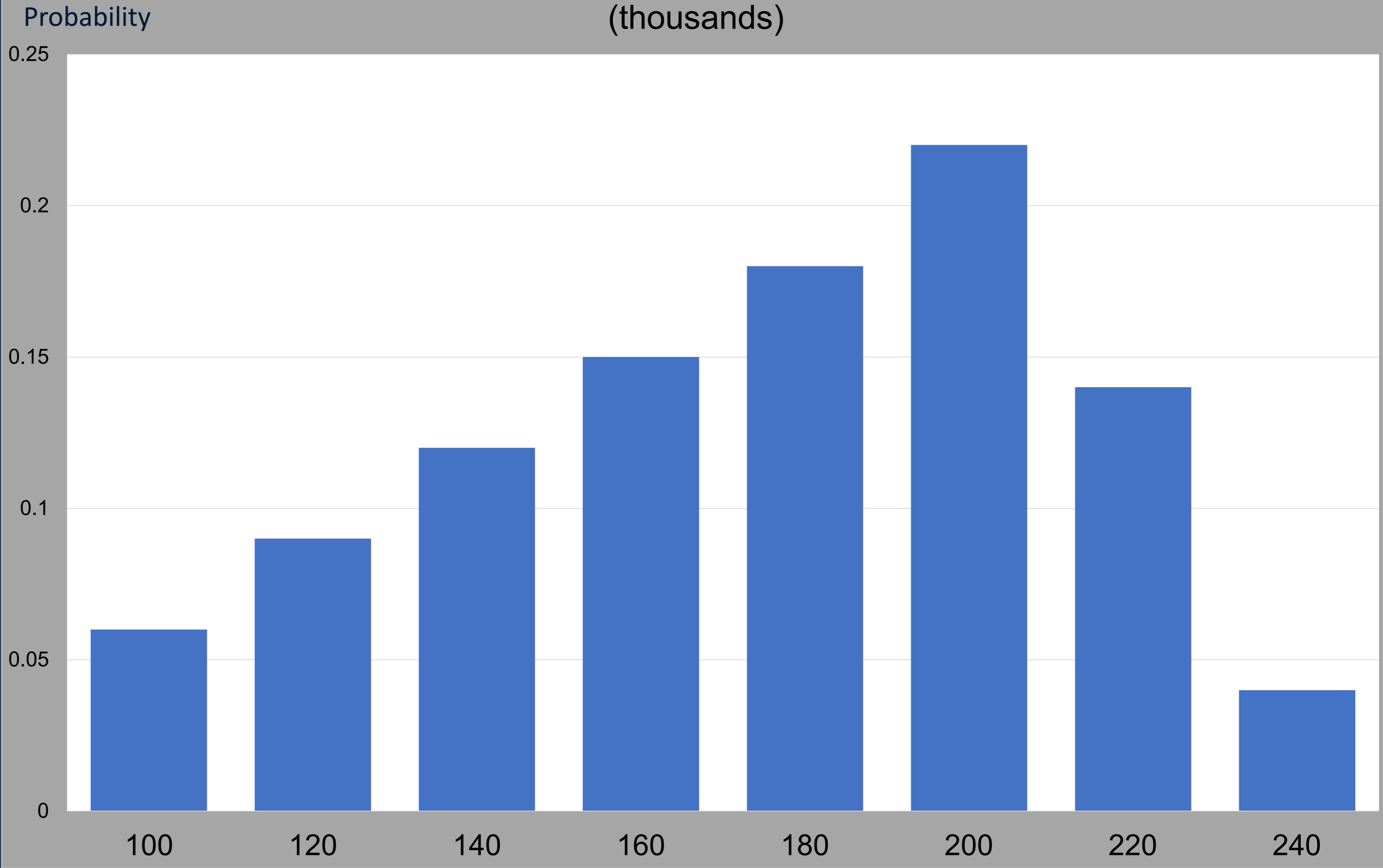
