## Foundation Trustee expectations are to:

- 1) Provide direction, ideas and oversight to the Florida Chamber Foundation. The Board of Trustees meet a minimum of three times a year, generally in conjunction with the Florida Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors meetings.
- 2) Participate as a thought leader in one of the Six Pillars of your choosing and in one or more of the statewide Six Pillars Caucuses.
- 3) Invest a minimum of \$10,000 in Trustee dues per year and assist fellow Trustees in outreach efforts to raise additional investments to support the Foundation's mission.
- 4) Participate in the implementation of Florida's long-term strategic plan: Florida 2030 Blueprint. The three-year research project was completed and key targets and strategies were released at the 2018 Future of Florida Forum. This is a roadmap to the future.
